SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Dennis O. Lynn

in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, am well and truly indebted unto the Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of Three Thousand and no/100 - - - (\$ 3,000.00 ) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of seven per cent ( 7 %) per annum, unpaid interest to

bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I the said Dennis O. Lynn, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Crizzens Building and Loan Association, Dollars to the said mortgagor... in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Crizzens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the road leading from Highland to O'Neal, thence N. 46-15 E. 150 feet to a stake in the field; thence N. 41-00 W. 150 feet to a stake in the field; thence S. 46-15 W. 150 feet to a nail and cap in the said road; thence with said road S. 41-00 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one-half acre  $(\frac{1}{2})$ , more or less.

The above described land lies on the northeast side of the said road and is a part of the same land recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 238, page 27.
