SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Charles T. Gentry
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to Canal Insurance Company
in the full and just sum of EIGHT THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$ 8,000.00) DOLLARS, to be paid Canal Insurance Company in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of five & three-fourths (5-3/4%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in (240) monthly installments as follows:
Beginning on the 1st day of July, 1958, and on the 1st day of each month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 56.17, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of June, 1978, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of June, 1978; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 56.17 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of five & three-fourths (5-3/4%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 8,000.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as herein provided, including any past due taxes or insurance premiums, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of 5-3/4% per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Charles T. Gentry, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Charles T. Gentry according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to me the said Charles T. Gentry in hand and truly paid by the said Canal Insurance Company at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Canal Insurance Company

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 17, in Block F, on the eastern side of Tiffany Drive, in Mayfair Estates, as shown on a plat thereof, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at pages 72 and 73; and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of Tiffany Drive, joint front corner with Lot No. 18 of said plat, and running thence N. 66-51 E. 100 feet along line of said Lot No. 18 to point, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 17, 18 and 19; thence N. 11-35 E. 85.3 feet along rear lines of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 to point, joint rear corner with Lot No. 16 in line of Lot No. 20; thence S. 66-51 W. 148.4 feet along line of Lot No. 16 to point on eastern side of Tiffany Drive; thence S. 23-09 E. 70 feet along the eastern side of Tiffany Drive to point of beginning.
