WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF

GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred & no/100. (\$ 6,200.00) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of Forty

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township on the Northeast side of Brushy Creek Road, about one mile South of Taylors, South Carolina, containing 1.15 acres, more or less, being a portion of tract No. 1 of a subdivision of the property of the N. G. Boling Estate, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at Page 223, and having, according to a plat of the property of A. C. McKinney, Jr. prepared by R. B. Bruce, Surveyor, June 18, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the Northeast side of Brushy Creek Road at the southernmost corner of the intersection of said road with a proposed fifty-foot street, and running thence along the Southeastern side of said proposed fifty-foot street, N. 45-50 E. 281.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 44-10 E. 154.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 46-50 W. 306.7 feet to an iron pipe on the Northeastern side of Brushy Creek Road; thence along the Northeastern side of Brushy Creek Road, N. 34-42 W. 150.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same lot conveyed to me by A. C. McKinney and Lillian Augusta McKinney, June 10, 1958 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 599 at Page 550.
