All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, and the improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the state and county aforesaid Chich Springs Township near Fairview Baptist Church, adjoining lands of R.B. Vaughn on the East, J.L. Nodine on Southm Suber Mill Road on the west and lands of George Nodine on the North, and being a part of two lots conveyed to me as follows; one lot conveyed to George Nodine by deed from R.B. Vaughn, "arch 31st. 1928 and recorded in Deed Book 133 at page 214; the other lot conveyed to George Nodine by deed from Miss Roxie M. Nodine and Mrs. Nannie Spooner November 3rd 1933 and recorded in Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County In Deed Book 180 at page 207 and having the following courses and distances; to wit:
