and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,  
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its  
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,  
State of South Carolina: on the southwestern side of Hill Street and being known  
and designated as Lot No. 16 on plat of property of J. Wayman Smith recorded  
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "FF", at Page  
534, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Hill Street at the  
joint front corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17 and running thence along said Street  
S. 41-15 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 15 and  
16 S. 48-47 W. 204.28 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 39-38 W. 100 feet to an iron  
pin; thence N. 48-47 E. 201.85 feet to the point of beginning.

ing or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be  
had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter  
attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

assigns forever.
