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All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina in the City of Greenville on the Eastern side of a new county road which leads from the Old Airport Road (formerly known as Pike Road) and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of Airport Road (formerly known as Pike Road) which point is 410 feet in a Westerly direction from the Northeastern corner of the property of Henry B.
