Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called, the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. DOUGLAS WILSON & CO., a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Fifteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$ 15,000.00), with interest from date at the rate of five and one-fourth per centum (5 1/4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Ninety and no/100 ----- Dollars (\$ 90.00), commencing on the first day of August, 1959, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 1984.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, known as a part of the property of Sue C. Ashmore, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Jourdan J. Newton, Greenville, S. C.", and having according to said plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in June, 1959, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southeasterly corner intersection of Brookside Way and Marshall Court, and running thence along Marshall Court, S. 23-51 E., 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-55 E., 85.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 25-30 W., 200 feet to an iron pin on Brookside Way; thence along Brookside Way S. 74-32 W., 80 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
