Wilkins,

All that lot of land situate on the south side of Carolina Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 33 on plat of Section A, of Gower Estates made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, January 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book QQ, pages 146 and 147, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Carolina Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 32 and 33, and run thence with the line of Lot 32, S. 24-39 W. 216.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-20 W. 102.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 34, N. 24-39 E. 195 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Carolina Avenue; thence along Carolina Avenue, S. 65-21 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
