thence S. 42 W. 84.5 feet to a point; thence with the line of other property of the mortgagors herein N. 12-50 W. 892 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 88-45 W. 537.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73 W. 697.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11 E. 208.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73 W. 208.5 feet to the point of beginning.
