All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, Country of Greenville, in Grove Township, containing 3.92 ecres, more or less, lying on the southern side of State Highway 294 and being more particularly described according to a survey prepared by J. C. Smith dated July 16, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book T at Page 197 as follows:
