WHEREAS: I, CARY ZANE GREY,

Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of TWELVE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND

NO/100 <sup>four</sup>-----Dollars (\$ 12,600.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-fourth per centum ( 5-1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of The Prudential Insurance Company of America in Newark, New Jersey, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of sixty-nine and 68/100 ----- Dollars (\$ 69.68 ), commencing on the first day of January, 19 63, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of November, 19 92.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns; the following described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina;

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the East side of West Dorchester Boulevard near the City of Greenville in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 110 on plat of Section One of Belle Meade Subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service, June, 1954, recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book EE, Pages 116 and 117. Said lot fronting 80 feet along the East side of West Dorchester Boulevard and running back to a depth of 160.9 feet on the South side; to a depth of 153.8 feet on the North side; and being 80.3 feet across the rear.

Should the Veterans' Administration fail or refuse to issue its guaranty of the loan secured by this instrument under the provisions of the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944, as amended, within sixty days from the date the loan would normally become eligible for such guaranty, the mortgagee herein may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
