Beginning on the N/8 of a county road, joint corners of Lots Nos. 33, 34, 19 and 20 and running with the common line of Lots 33 and 34, N 23-00 W, 231 feet to an iron pin; thence N 71-45 E, 80.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S 37-10 E, 104 feet to an iron pin; thence S 37-10 E, 23 feet to an iron pin; thence S 37-40 E, 45 feet; thence S 11-00 W, 40 feet; thence S 34-00 W, 36 feet to an iron pin; thence S 39-50 W, 40 feet to an iron pin; thence S 45-30 W, 40 feet to the point of beginning, being subject to such rights-of-way or easements as may have been previously given.
