"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the western side of Linden Drive, shown as Lot #8 on a plat entitled "Revisions Lots 7 and 8 Pinehurst - Section 2" recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville Gounty in Plat Book MM at Page 156, and being further described as follows:
