All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with the improvements thereon situate, lying, and being at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Ansel and Means Streets, City, County, and Township of Greenville, South Carolina, and according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service dated June 17, 1954, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Ansel and Means Streets, and running thence S. 31-34 W. 116 feet along the western side of Means Street to a point; thence N. 63-22 W. 75.3 feet, more or less, along the line of property conveyed by Robert Johnson to Janie M.
