



PERSONALLY appeared before me W. A. Hopkins, an officer of the Pelzer-Williamston Bank of South Carolina, who being duly sworn according to law, deposes and says:

That on or about October 26, 1944, Mr. L. E. Watt executed a mortgage to the Pelzer Williamston Bank covering some 14 acres of land, more or less, which is now owned by Carrie R. Jenkins. This mortgage was in the original amount of \$2,250.00 and is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 330, at page 89. Mr. Watt later conveyed this property to Mr. H. D. Watson on December 12, 1944, and Mr. Watson assumed said mortgage. On November 14, 1946 Mr. Watson conveyed this property to John H. and Carrie R. Jenkins, deed recorded in Book 303, page 118, RMC Office for Greenville County, and Mr. and Mrs. Jenkins assumed and agreed to pay the balance of this mortgage.

That the said mortgage has not been assigned, hypothecated or otherwise disposed of, and has been lost or destroyed and after diligent search cannot be found. That the Pelzer Williamston Bank, which he represents, is the bona fide owner and holder of said mortgage.
