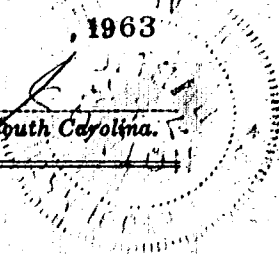
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
