"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lyingsand being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Rasor Drive shown as all of Lot No. 4 and the adjoining 25 feet of Lot No. 3 on a plat entitled Property of F. B. Talley recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book CC at Page 105 and being further shown on a survey entitled property of A.M. Harper, et al, prepared by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., dated April 7, 1962, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Rasor Drive at a point 1,077.6 feet in a southerly direction from Woodland Drive and running thence S. 71-17 E. 260 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-43 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-17 W. 260 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Rasor Drive; thence along the eastern side of Rasor Drive, N. 18-43 E. feet to the point of beginning.
