- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.

Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this meritgage, or should the Mortgage become a party of any sont involving this Mortgage to the title to the premises described bergin, or should the hereby or guize-part thereof be placed in the hands of any attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise; all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgage, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and pavable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt-secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
- (7) That the Mortgager shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgager shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and coverants of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and views.
- (6) That the covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inuic to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular shall included the planal, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
