a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina is well and truly indebted

to the mortgagee in the full and just sum of Eleven Thousand and No/100 (\$11,000.00) Dollars

and by its certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on or before six (6) months from the date hereof, and upon demand thereafter,

with interest from the date hereof at the rate of Five and One-Half (5 1/2%) percentum until paid; interest to be computed and paid Semi-Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including ten per cent of the indebtedness as attorney's fee, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens & Southern National Bank, its Successors and Assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with any improvements thereon, situate, lying, and being on the southeastern side of Birch Court, Beechwood Hills Subdivision, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as Lot 17 on a plat of said subdivision, recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for said County in Plat Book "QQ", Page 35, according to which plat said lot is described more particularly as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Birch Court, joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17, and running thence S. 50-05 E. 342.1 feet along the joint line of said lots to a point in the center of a branch, joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the center line of said branch in a southwestern direction to a point which is the joint rear corner of Lots 17 and 18; thence N. 66-00 W. 357.5 feet along the joint line of said lots to an iron pin on the southeastern side of said Court, joint front corner of said lots; thence along the southeastern side of said Court along a curve, the chord of which is N. 26-47 E., 82.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 39-55 E. 67.1 feet still along the southeastern side of said Court to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
