Brown Estate by Woodward Engineering Co., February, 1957 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 00, page 320, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING at an iron pin on a country road leading to Stanton Bridge Road at the corner of property formerly deeded to E. W. Brown, Jr. running thence N. 23-48 W. 100 feet to a point, thence S. 84-24 W. to a point; thence S. 6 E. 100 feet to the center of said county road; thence up the center of said road N. 84-24 W. 277 feet to the point of beginning.
