"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oneal Township, on the South side of the Oneal-Berry's Mill Road, containing 50.6 Acres, more or less, and being shown as the property of Florence S. Holtzclaw according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated August 30, 1943, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:
