WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor(s) in and by their certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted to The First National Bank of Greer,

a Corporation,

hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of

One Thousand (\$1000.00) - - - - - DOLLARS.

to be paid as follows: \$48.00 on February 15, 1964, and \$48.00 on the 15th day of each month thereafter until paid in full, each of said payments to be applied first to interest and the balance to the principal,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, as stated above, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of Ashmore Street in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 17 of the J.D. Ashmore property according to survey and plat thereof by H. L. Brockman, Surveyor, recorded in Plat Book "P", page 175, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, having a width of 50 feet and a depth of 179 feet on the east side and 173.7 feet on the west side.
