WHEREAS, Pleasantburg Shopping Center, Inc., a South Carolina Corporation, is well and truly indebted to PROVIDENT LIFE AND ACCIDENT IN-SURANCE COMPANY, Chattanooga, Tennessee, in the full and just amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100 (\$250,000.00) Dollars in and by its certain promissory note, in writing, of even date herewith, of which the following is a copy:

"For value received, Pleasantburg Shopping Center, Inc., a South Carolina Corporation, jointly and severally promises to pay to the order of PROVIDENT LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE COMPANY the principal sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100 (\$250,000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. per annum, said interest and principal sum to be paid as follows:

"Beginning on the first day of April, 1964, and on the first day of each month thereafter, the sum of Two Thousand Forty-Two and 71/100 Dollars, to be applied on the principal and interest of this note until the first day of March, 1979, when any balance remaining due on principal, with accrued interest, shall be payable in full. The aforesaid monthly payments of \$2,042.71 Dollars each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of 5½ per cent. per annum on the principal sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars, or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid, and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal; all installments of principal and interest of this note being payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the Home Office of PROVIDENT LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE COMPANY in Chattanooga, Tennessee, or at such other place as the holder hereof may from time to time designate in writing.
