if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of APRIL, 1994

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better  
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three  
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,  
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its  
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of GREENVILLE,  
State of South Carolina:

ALL THAT CERTAIN PIECE, PARCEL OR LOT OF LAND, SITUATE,  
LYING AND BEING ON THE NORTHWESTERN SIDE OF CROSBY CIRCLE NEAR

had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and  
assigns forever.
