NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township on waters of Gilders Creek and lying on the Pelham-Batesville Road containing 6.78 acres, more or less, as shown on survey made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, on January 3, 1940, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in Pelham-Batesville Road at corner of land now or formerly belonging to F. B. Jones and running thence with said road S. $55\frac{1}{2}$ W. 358.5 feet to an iron pin at corner of property now or formerly belonging to Mrs. T. E. King, and running thence N. 15 W. 800 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83 E. 123.5 feet to a wild cherry stump and iron pin; thence N. 69 E. 378 feet to iron pin at corner of F. B. Jones tract; thence along line of said tract S. 51 E. 671 feet to the beginning corner.
