

maturities; however, while any bonds of the first series are outstanding no bonds of a subsequent series shall be issued other than for the purpose of acquiring additional real property, improving and equipping existing or subsequently acquired real property or retiring indebtedness secured by any real property of the Church. While any bond of this issue (including additional series thereunder) is outstanding, no mortgage shall be given to secure any subsequent indebtedness incurred by the Church except on subsequently acquired Church property no part of which is purchased with proceeds of this bond issue.

7. That the Church hereby adopts as its seal, for the purpose of executing all instruments in connection with this bond issue the seal appearing on the foregoing form for said bonds.

8. That the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Church is hereby authorized and directed to execute the aforesaid Bond Indenture (Exhibit A) which is incorporated herein as a part of this resolution to the same extent as if copied herein verbatim and to certify to this resolution as the act and deed of the Church and to file this resolution together with an executed copy of said bond indenture as an Exhibit thereto for record in the office of the County Clerk or appropriate Recorder of Deeds of the County where the Church property is located.
