with interest from date at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Ernest J. Gosnell and Minnie L. Gosnell, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank as Trustee for Hughes Affiliates Profit Sharing Plan, its successors and assigns: all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southeast side of Panther Road, and now or formerly bounded by lands of Henry Gosnell, Mrs. F. C. Bright and Sallie Bright containing 50 acres, more or less, being the same property conveyed to Clint Thomas by Nancy M. Brown by deed dated August 18, 1956 and recorded in the R.M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 559, at page 388.

This tract was originally the Carter home place and is a part of the property acquired by Nona B. Campbell from Newberry Carter and others by deed recorded in said R.M.C. office in Deed Book 187, Page 128.
