BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North ##### corner bordering the land of Ethel Pridmore, in the center of the Babbtown Road and running thence S. 50-45 W. 220 feet to an iron pin along and adjacent to the land of Ethel Pridmore; thence S. 21-48 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-45 E. 220 feet to a nail in the center of the Babbtown Road; thence N. 21-48 W. 100 feet along the center of the Babbtown Road to the point of beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to mortgagor by Ethel Pridmore by deed recorded in Deed Book 709 at page 246 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
