All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Highland Township, this being a part of the Bonnie Hart homeplace and lying north of the Tugaloo Road, bounded on the east by lands of marry Lee Hart, on the north by land of Floyd Flumley, on the west and south by lands of Mary H. Jordan and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
