with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven (7) per centum per annum, to be paid: monthly.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or let of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, on the West side of the Old U. S. Highway 29 (also known as the Old Greenville-Piedmont Highway), in Gantt Township, Greenville County, S. C., and being known as Lot 1, on a plat of the Estate of W. C. Cleveland, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "EE", Page 9, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Old U. S. Highway 29 at corner of property now or formerly of Jack Anderson, and running thence along said Anderson line, N. 78-0 W., 295 feet more or less to a point in the center of the Piedmont & Northern Railroad track; thence with the center of said railroad track S. 12-05 E., 200 feet more or less to a point in the center of said track in the North edge of a 50-foot road; thence along the North edge of said road in an Easterly direction, 42.5 feet more or less to an iron pin at the rear Southwest corner of Lot 1; thence continuing along the North side of said 50-foot road, S. 76-50 E., 238.5 feet to an iron pin at the Northwest corner of intersection of said 50-foot road and Old U.
