Beginning on the 10th day of , 19 69 , and on the 10th day of each month March of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 140.09and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 10th day of January 1979 , and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 10th day of February monthly payments of \$ 140.09 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of Six & 3/4-- (6 3/66) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 12,200.00 so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or convenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
