NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, on the eastern side of St. Marks Road and known and designated as Lots Nos. 9, 10 and 20 of a subdivision known as property of Eugene A. McConnell, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Q at Page 95 and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of St. Marks Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9 and running thence N. 64-53 E., 397 feet to an iron pin; running thence N. 32-51 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 64-53 W., 379 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of St. Marks Road; running thence with the eastern side of said road S. 22-0 E., 100 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
