"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, of hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being designated as lot No. 55 at the southwest corner of Parkins Mill Road and Barksdale Road, according to a plat of revised portion of Barksdale made September 1961 by Dalton & Neves, recorded in plat book QQ at page 118 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.
