NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand paid by second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, including but not limited to, all trees, timber, shrubbery, fixtures and improvements now and hereafter thereon:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 4.7 acres, more or less, on the western side of Taylors Road, as shown on a plat of property of Rebecca B. Vinson, prepared April 28, 1969, by James D. Crain, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book SSS at Page 189, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to-wit:
