All those lots pieces or parcels of land known and designated as Lots Nos. 67 and 68 of Plat No. 1 of the Property of the Tryon Development Company, known as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C.E., and duly recorded in the Office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 41.

ALSO: All that certain piece or parcel of land in the Lake Lanier Subdivision, Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying, being and situate on the south side of East Lake Shore Drive and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of East Lake Shore Drive, said iron pin bearing S 35-09 W 31.8 feet from the front corner of lots 68 and 69 in the Lake Lanier Subdivision, running thence S 25-33 W 9.2 feet to an iron pin at the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier, running thence along the edge of the waters of Lake Lanier, S 89-12 W 22.9 feet to an iron pin, running thence N 27-13 E 18.5 feet to an iron pin on the south side of East Lake Shore Drive, running thence S 66-57 E 20 feet to an iron pin, being the paint of beginning. Reference is hereby made to plat made by H. B. Frankenfield, Jr., dated July 19, 1956. Reference is also made to plat made for Tryon Development Company by George Kershaw, C. E., dated 1925 and duly recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County.
