TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plumbing and electrical fixtures, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it belog the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the really.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encumbrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises and the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises and the the he same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the pryment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes; and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as that provided in said note and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgage, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgage and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgage and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgage; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate motive thereof to the Mortgage registered mail; and should the Mortgage at any time fall to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premiers in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagor immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagor may at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebted-the hearby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, nor alienate said premises by way of mortgage or deed of conveyance without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, and should the Mortgagor so encumber or alienate such premises, the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
