hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of **FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00)**----- DOLLARS,

to be paid at the rate of \$100.00 per month until paid in full, in payments of principal and interest, first payment due within 30 days and payments due each month thereafter. Payments first applied to interest and then to principal.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
