Consolidated Credit Corporation of Greenville, South Carolina, Inc. the following described property being real estate situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, mear Greenville, South Carolina, known as Lot No. 18h, Section 2 of the subdivision known as Oak Crest according to Plat of G.C. Jones, dated January1955, and recorded in the MMC Office for Greenville County in Blat Book GG at Pages 130 and 131, and having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit;
