NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesatd debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, soll and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Terramont Circle, being shown as Lot 7 on plat of Terra Pines Estate recorded in Plat Book PPP at pages 18 and 19, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Terramont Circle at the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7 and running thence with Lot 6, S 59-04 W 200.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N 35-20 W 255 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 8; thence with line of Lot 8, N 78-20 E 265 feet to an iron pin on Terramont Circle; thence with the curve of said circle, S 18-02 E 80 feet; thence continuing S 23 E 89.5 feet to the beginning owner.
