TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all heating, plambing and electrical fixtures, and any inher equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.
