

(4) Whether or not the note is insued by the Government, the Government may at any time pay any other amounts required herein to be paid by Borrower and not paid by him when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, preservation, or andorcement of this lies, as advances for the account of Borrower. - (6) To use the loan evidenced by the note solely for purposes authorized by the Government.
- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbrances and assessments lawfully attaching to or sessessed against the property and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts evidencing such payments.
  - (8) To keep the property insured as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.
- (8) To maintain improvements in good repair and make repairs required by the Government; operate the property in a good and hashandeun-like manner; oppply selly such farm consistently practice; and farm and bones densignated plans as the Government from time to line may practice; and not to abshood the property, for cluster or perit west, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or, without the written consent of the Government, cut, senove, or lesse any timber, gravel, oil, gas, coal, or other minerial scapely may be necessary for ordinary domestic purposes.
- (10) If this instrument is given for a "Farm Ownership" loan as identified in Farmers Home Administration regulations, parsonally to operate the property with his own and his family's labor as a farm and for no other purpose, and not to leave the property or any part of it unless the Government consents in switing to some other method of operation or to a leave. If this instrument is given for a "sentent of the property with the personally occupied and used by Dorrower and not 502 Rural Hooslog" loan on a "nonfarm tract," as so identified, the property will be personally occupied and used by Dorrower and not rented or leased without the Government's written consent.
  - (11) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property,

(13) Neither the properly nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be assigned, sold, transferred, or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as mortgagen hereunder, including but not limited to the power to great consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no insured lender shall have any right, title or interest in or to the lien or any benefits hereof.

- (14) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agree-ants contained herein or in any supplementary agreement are being performed.
- (15) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and reamortize the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government accuracy hereby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subsciliants the liten hereof, and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the lien or priority hereof or the liability to the Government of Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indichtedness secured hereby excepts as specified by the Government in writing.
- (16) If at any time it shall socear to the Government that Borrower may be able to obtain a loan from a production credit essociation, If you want the state of the security of the s such loan.
- (17) Default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate, or under any personal property or other, security instrument held or insured by the Government and executed of assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder
- (18) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation ascured by this instrument, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower die or be declared an incompetent, a bankrupt, or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors. parties named as Borrower die or de decemend as incompetent, a nontroph, or an innovent, or mass an assignment on the central cristors, the Government hereby secured inmediately due and payable, (b) for the account of Borrower incur and pay resconding expenses for repair or maintenance of and take possession of, operate or rent the property; (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without notice of hearing of said application, have a receiver appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, (d) oraclose fulls instrument as provided herein or by issue, and (a) saignees and and indired the property of the property
