MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, W. C. Bumby, of Greenville County,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) in the full and just sum of

Thirteen Thousand and No/100------ (5 13,000,00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpoid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abile by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgace, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole anount due thereunder shall, at the eption of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgager, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any transport may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgager's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dalhas (\$\$100) to the Mattgager in had well and truly paid by the Mortgager at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby asknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgager, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or led of land with all improvement, therein an electricity from aid the string stude, being addition in the State of Sauth County or "Greenville, being known aid the signature as Lot 35 of Huntly Acres, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "WWW" at Page 20, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Lilly Street, joint front corner of Lots 34 and 35 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 33-20 E. 155.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-11 E. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 35 and 36; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 33-20 W. 155.1 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Lilly Street; thence with the southern side of Lilly Street, S. 56-27 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Talley Realty, Inc. by deed dated August 25, 1969."
