All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Briarcliff Drive (Formerly Park Road), in the City of Greenville, Count of Greenville State of South Carolina and known and designated as Lot #2 of the property of William Goldsmith, platof which is recorded in Plat Book F at page 190, which plat is a resubdivison of Lots Number 3 and Number 4 of a resubdivision known as East Overbrook, plat' of which is recorded in RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at page 159 and according to first mentioned plat has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
