MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

O. H. OGLE

....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

therein specified in installments of Two Hundred Sixteen and 11/100----- (\$216.11)
Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in tall, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpud principal balances, and then the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sconer paid, to be due and payable...92.....years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and ablde by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with cests and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgage to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, at hereafter to be constructed thereon, states of Rosewood Drive, being shown as Lot No. 55 on plat of Edwards Forest Heights prepared by Jones Engineering Service, dated February, 1967 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 000, Page 87, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Rosewood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 57 and 58 and running thence with the line of said lots 88-41 W 130 feet to the joint corner of said lots with Lot 64; thence with Lots 58 and 64 N 42-42 W 100 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 58, 59, 63, and 64; thence with the joint line of Lots 58 and 59 N 71-56 E 181.5 feet to an iron pin on Rosewood Drive; thence with Rosewood Drive S 23-17 E 10.5 feet; thence continuing S 17-50 E 49.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing S 7-07 E 49.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing S 1-29 E 20.6 feet to the point of beginning.
