ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the eastern side of an unnamed street leading from Washington Avenue and according to survey of property of Zet Smith made by J. Mac Richardson in April 1951, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern side of said 30-foot street (now known as Prospect Street) at corner of property now or formerly of Bertha Boyd, which is also 157.5 feet south from property now or formerly of 0. C. Fleming, and running thence with the Boyd property, S. 57-00 B. 210 feet to a stake; thence S. 34-00 E. 52.5 feet to stake; thence N. 57-00 W. 210 feet to stake; thence N. 34-00 E. 52.5 feet to the point of beginning."

Simpson by deed dated September 15, 1964 and recorded in Deed Vol. 757 at Page 383. The name "Roosevelt Chapman" is erroneous and fictitious and is intended to be the mortgagor, Rosa Bell Chaney Sitton.
