

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of Wares-Old Hundred Road, and designated as Tract No. 2, of the subdivision of the W. H. King land, as shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, August, 1951, and according to said plat has the following courses and distances to-wit:

H. King land; on the South by said road; on the West by Tract No. 1, being conveyed to J. B. King, and Ellis King.
