....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunds shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgager to the Mortgagor's recount, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgage at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgage, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon or hereofter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 249, Section 6, Sheet One, of a subdivision known as Colonial Hills, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated March 21, 1968 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WWW at Page 12 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Creighton Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 248 and 249, and running thence along the northern side of Creighton Street, S. 73-26 W. 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 250; thence along the line of that lot, N. 16-35 W. 199.4 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 219; thence along the rear lines of Lots Nos. 219 and 220, following the center line of a power line right-of-way, N. 73-31 E. 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 248; thence along the line of that lot, S. 16-35 E. 199.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by W. N. Leslie by his deed dated October 8, 1969, to be recorded herewith.

The mortgagor's promissory note referred to above, contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
