together with all rights, interests, assuments, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, the rects, issues, and profile thereof and avenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property now or later, situated thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, all water, water gights, and water stack persisting thereto, and all payments at any time owing to Borrower by victue of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein-all of which are been called "the property";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever.

BORROWER for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any licent, ancumbrances, easements, recentrations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- (i) To pay promptly when does my indebtadness to the Government hereby sectived and to indennify and save hemiess the Government sealingt any loss under its insurance of payment of the note he note to reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection egent for the holder.
- (2) To pay the Government any initial fees for inspection and appraisal, and any delinquency charges, now or hereafter required by regulations of the Parmers Home Administration.
- (2) At all lines when the note is held by an insured leader, say amount due and ungaid under the terms of the sois, less the amount of any amoust charge, may be paid by the Government to the holder of the note as provided in the note and insurance endorsament for the account of Berower. Any amount due and ungaid under the terms of the note, whether it is held by the Government or by an interest indee, may be credited by the Government on the note, and thereupon shall constitute an advance by the Government for the account of Borovers. Any advance by the Government as described in this paragraph shall bear interest at the note rate from the date on which the amount of the advance by the Government for the account of Borovers.
