The Grantors, in order to more fully protect the security of this deed of trust, agree, if requested to do so by the Insurance Company, that in addition to the payments of principal and interest under the terms of the note-hereby secured, they will pay to the Insurance Company, on each date on which monthly payments are due under the terms of the aforesaid note, as sun equal to one-wellful of the known or estimated (by the Insurance Company) yearly taxes, assessments and insurance premiums on or against the mortgaged premises.
