MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgager) in the full and just sum of Minetean

Thousand Five Hundred and no/100

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

therein specified in installments of One Hundred Fifty and 51/100 150.51 Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due therrunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe in the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, borgained, sold, and reliened, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real gatate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the easterly side of Great Glen Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 163 on plat entitled Del Norte Estates, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book WWW, at Pages 32 and 33 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Great Glen Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 162 and 163 and running thence with the common line of said Lots N 37-24 E 167.4 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 162 and 163; thence N 51-27 W 50 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 163. 164 and 166; thence with the common line of Lots 163 and 164 N 76-12 W 106 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Great Glen Road; thence with the easterly side of Great Glen Road S 2-23 E 153.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 36-59 E 41.15 feet to an iron pin; thence S 71-36 E 10 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The Mortgagor's promissory note referred to above, contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
